

Kosovo, the commune of Gjilan votes today for the third time

Officials of the Central Elections Commission in Kosovo declared that in Gjilan all the voting centers are open and the voting process is continuing without problems. The voting centers are open even in two Serbian localities including the village Burdige that has had problems in the first two rounds.

In the commune of Gjilan there are 87.430 habitants that will choose the new headman with a mandate of four years. It is said that the participation in the voting process is lower but there are no official figures yet.

Running for the commune of Gjilan are Qemajl Mustafa of the Democratic Party of Kosovo and Fatmir Rexhepi of the Democratic Joint of Kosovo. The elections in Gjilan are being held again because of the irregularities in the balloting of December 13th.
