

Belgium presidency of EU makes appeal: solve the crisis within November

In the first presentation after taking the presidency of EU, the Belgium ambassador makes an appeal to the politicians of Albania to solve the crisis in 5 months. Even though without headquarter in Tirana, Mark Mishelsen said in the name of EU that awaits signals by the opposition and the majority for a transparent solving of the situation.

“During the meeting I had with the 4 Albanian politicians we discussed even for the interior situation in Albania. I delivered them the message that there should be more progress and more positive signals. That is why we have expressed the concern about the political crisis in Albania that has to do with the missing dialogue and the non-solving of the issues of the last elections. I make an appeal to the politicians I met to look at these issues in a transparent and constitutional way. Opposition and majority should cooperate to find the solution. I hope that the EP resolution will be read carefully by the Albanian politicians to move forward”, said Mark Mishelsen, the Belgium ambassador for Albania.

Among the 5 main priorities of the Belgium presidency is also the expansion that will not be stopped like Germany pretends. Also the liberalization of visas will be based in technical criteria. The Belgium ambassador for Albania with headquarter in Rome presented the program of the Belgium presidency to the Prime Minister Berisha, the head of the state Topi, that of the parliament Topalli and to the minister Meta.
